Principals' Survey-2004

Background

354 schools were sent surveys to measure the perceived effectiveness of recent teacher education graduates of Buffalo State College. 40% of the surveys were returned.

Principal's were asked to provide an overall rating for all teachers hired in the last two years who earned their bachelor's and/or master's degree from Buffalo State College. They rated Buffalo State graduates on the following six criteria:

- 1. **Content knowledge**: Teacher demonstrates through knowledge of subject matter area and curriculum.
- 2. **Preparation:** Teacher demonstrates appropriate preparation employing the necessary pedagogical practices to support instruction.
- 3. **Instruction delivery**: The delivery of instruction results in active student involvement, appropriate teacher/student interaction and meaningful lesson plans resulting in student learning.
- 4. **Student development**: Teacher displays knowledge of student development, an understanding and appreciation of diversity and the regular application of developmentally appropriate instructional strategies for benefit of all students.
- 5. **Student assessment**: Teacher implements assessment techniques based on appropriate learning standards designed to measure students' progress in learning.
- 6. **Collaboration:** Teacher develops effective collaborative relationships with students, parents, or caregivers, as needed and appropriate support personnel to meet the learning needs of students.

Each of these standards was evaluated on a scale from 1-5 with 5=always, 4=usually, 3=sometimes, 2=rarely, 1=never with 0=don't know.

Results

127 surveys were returned and completed, 12 were returned but not completed for a variety of reasons, and 7 were returned from school that had not hired any Buffalo State graduates in the last two years.

The overall average ratings are:

The highest ratings were achieved in content and collaboration. Student development and student assessment received the lowest ratings.
